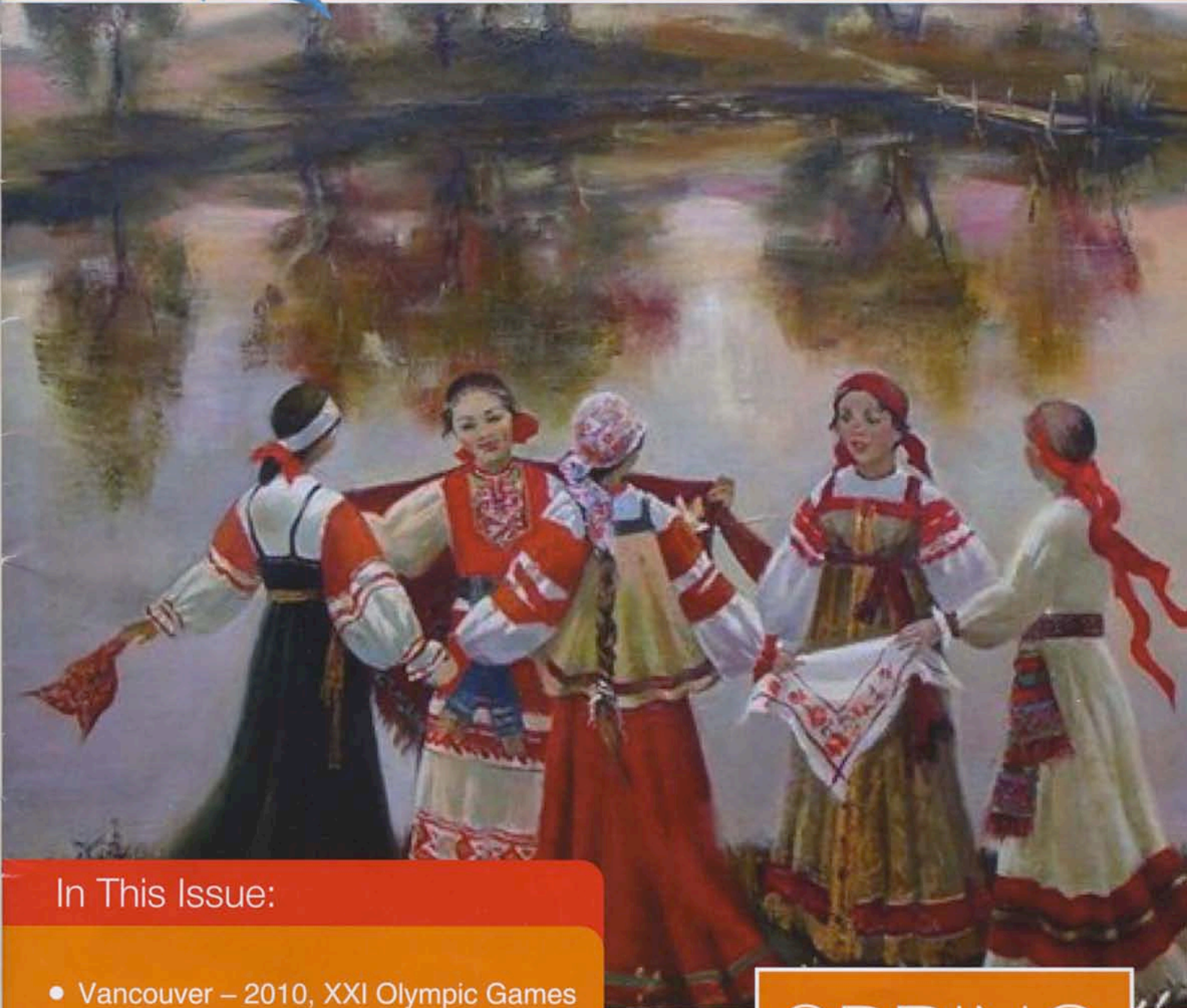

DEC DESIGN – A NEW VANCOUVER CERBA MEMBER



On March 14-19 the Regional Coordinator of CERBA Vancouver Chapter Tatyana Domilovskaya accompanied DEC-Design Mechanical Consultants to the International Real Estate Show (MIPIM) in Cannes. DEC Design - a new Vancouver CERBA member – is an innovative, Canadian engineering corporation working at the leading edge of sustainable systems design and construction for over 30 years. At the forefront of engineering sustainability, DEC has developed a district heating and cooling solution called District Energy Sharing System (DESS), a low-temperature, shared-resource approach that distributes heating, cooling, and in some cases reclaimed water to interconnected buildings within a community and has the ability to reduce the required energy consumption by up-to 50%. When recovering heat from wastewater treatment plants or other industrial processes, the DESS provides a vehicle for distributing reclaimed water for non-potable applications, further reducing potable water demand by up to 40%.

DEC's participation at the show followed a successful initial contact with Yury Rysin, the Head of Krasnodar Urban Development and Architecture Department visited Vancouver during the Olympics 2010 within the delegation of Krasnodar region. CERBA Vancouver Chapter had organized for Mr. Rysin a program of meetings with BC companies involved into the Olympic construction.

At MIPIM DEC was represented by President Mr. Dale Carter and Senior Project Engineer Mr. Erik Lindquist. Both met with Vice Governor of Krasnodar region Mr. Khtuov, Mayor of Krasnodar Mr. Evlanov, Regnum bank Chairman of Directory Board, Mr. Primakov and a number of government officials and investors. Meetings and negotiations resulted by signing a framework agreement with Regnum Holding and Urban Development and Architecture Department of Krasnodar region for application of district heating, cooling and water purification system at the newly developed project «Southern Star» in Tuapse area.

A number of other promising opportunities for CERBA members were identified during this visit and CERBA Vancouver will continue to develop this area of cooperation.
